- 3) Once your application is accepted you will be sent an acceptance/invoice that will include payment options and instructions.
- 4) There are only a limited number of major food vendor spaces.
Major food vendors are chosen by menu selection and a first come basis, we like to offer a variety of foods without a lot of crossovers. All food vendor sites are the same price.
- 5) All vendors are expected to have a clean professional set-up that corresponds to the items they are selling. Management reserves the right to request removal of any set-up, item or display it deems inappropriate, in poor taste or against health codes. No refund will be given.

Food Vendors may sell Cajun style dishes but may not sell
boiled crawfish, alcohol or bagged ice.

Booth Operator assumes full and complete responsibility and will hold harmless the Big Creek Country Cajun Festival, Deepwater Holdings, Inc. and the United States Army Corp of Engineers, its officers, directors, servants, agents, employees or volunteers from any loss, lost profits, damage or injury to the person or property of the Booth Operator or Booth Operator's agents, customers, or invitees. It is further agreed that Booth Operator or Booth Operator's agents, customers, or invitees. It's further agreed that booth Operator shall maintain his/her space, merchandise, activities and business practices in compliance with all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations. Booth Operators understand that violation of or noncompliance with this release or any rule, regulation, law, ordinance, or decree may result in immediate expulsion of Booth Operator and his/her exhibit from the Festival without a refund of any applicable booth or rental fees paid.

All participation by vendors, their agents or volunteers will adhere to the following rules;

- 1) Check-in for vendors and accommodations starts at 8 am to 4 pm on Friday March 23.
Those with on-site accommodation must check-out by 3 pm on Sunday.
Friday night festivities start at 6 pm and will end at 11 pm
Saturday festivities starts at 10 am -11pm with the exception of the cook-off
which starts at 8am Saturday morning.
- 2) Vendor's failure to occupy assigned space by 4:00 pm on Friday will be considered cancellation of the contract and Exhibitor will forfeit any fees paid. All vehicles must be removed from vendor area by 5pm (NO EXCEPTIONS). After that time vendors will have to carry merchandise into the vendor area.
- 3) All vendors and activities shall conduct business from within the confines of their assigned space. Vendors will be required to keep their spaces neat and attractive, free from trash and debris. They will be responsible for picking up their own trash and depositing it in provided receptacles throughout the park. Vendors are encouraged to decorate their booths and appropriate banners and signs are permitted at the vendors assigned space provided they relate directly to the vendor. Business sponsorships are available for companies they would like their banner displayed during the festival.
- 4) **For the safety of everyone involved no vendor may attempt to move out of the vendor area until after 11pm on Saturday night.**
- 5) Absolutely No Refunds , Transfers, Subletting. Spaces may be shared only upon approval of Festival Management.
- 6) CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES
- 7) Pets must be restrained at all times. A non-refundable pet fee of \$200 is required for pets in cabins.
- 8) Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying Texas Sales Tax and must have a valid sales tax permit number and be in good standing to participate.
- 9) No offensive noise or distractions are permitted at the Festival.
- 10) Loud generators will not be allowed in the vendor area or common Festival areas.
Use of quiet non-disruptive generators is allowed.
- 11) All vendors are expected to have a clean professional set-up that corresponds to the items they are selling. Festival Management reserves the right to request removal of any set-up, item or display it deems inappropriate, in poor taste or against health codes.
No refund will be given.
- 12) There will be no fireworks, poppers, or silly string sold at the festival.
Vendors violating this rule will be asked to leave the festival.
- 13) No glass containers allowed in park.
- 14) There will be a designated parking area for vendors who do not have a campsite or cabin.
Please secure your vehicle and property.
- 15) Festival Management reserves the right to change vendors assigned space.
